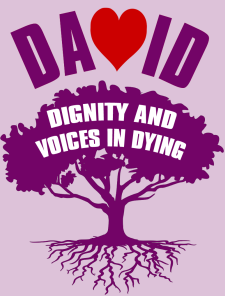

If this is not possible you can print in black and white, then colour in the game pieces and stick the two sides of each piece together.



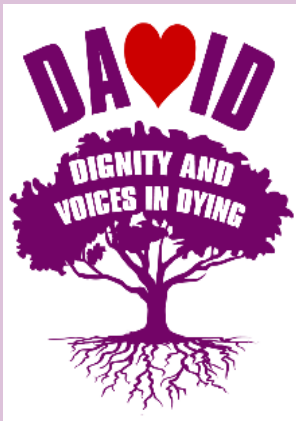

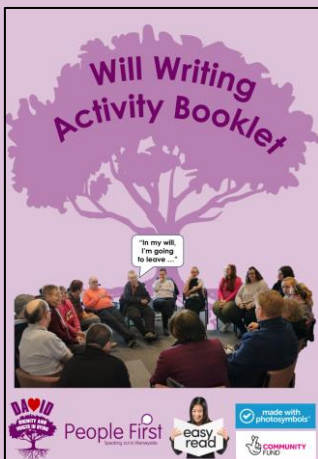

This resource booklet was made by people with learning disabilities and autism on the DAVID Project.



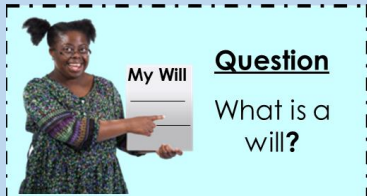

A solicitor can help you write your will.



Executors are people who make sure that your will is carried out when you die.



You can choose anyone over 18 to be our executor

Yes, you can change your will any time you want.

It is a good idea to check your will every few years



An experienced solicitor can assess if you have capacity to make a will.



You can leave anything you own in your will, such as your money, books, CD's or clothes.



You can leave your things to anyone, such as your friends and family or a charity



You can write a will if you are over 18.



Yes! You can choose a friends or a family member to be your executor.



A will makes sure you can choose who has your money and your things after you die.

2 witnesses must see you sign your will.



If you use a solicitor, it makes it harder for people to disagree with your will after you die.
